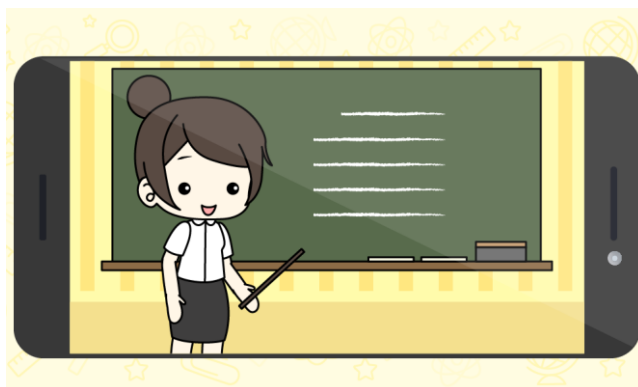
- 1) Fees:

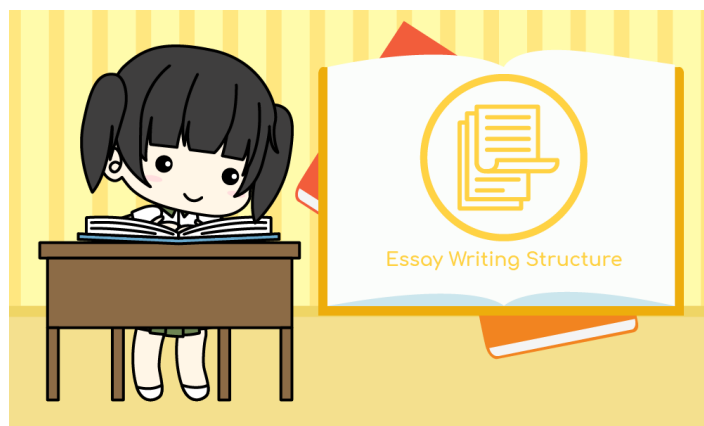

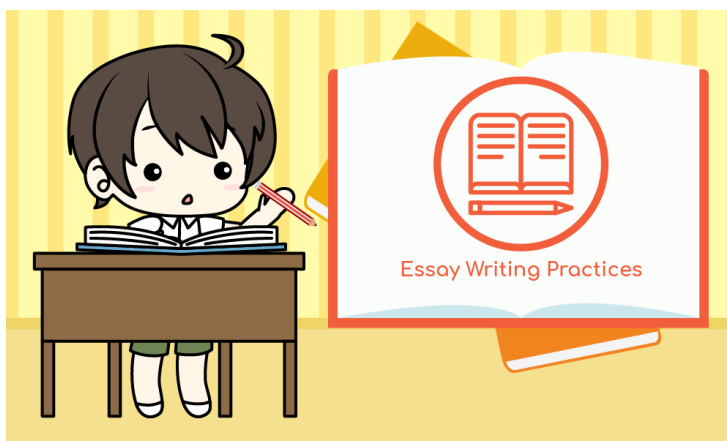

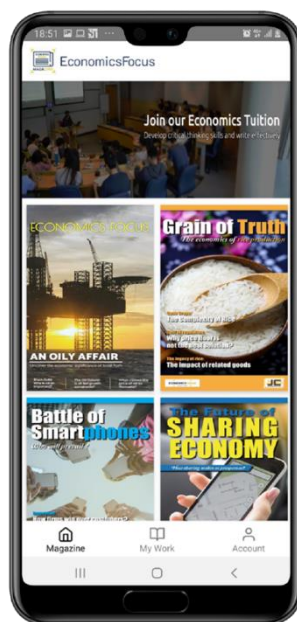
